WHAT IS “MUSICAL IN A WEEK”?

Musical in a Week is an intensive, super-fun school holiday program where a cast of 11–18-year-olds learn and perform a full junior musical (show length approx. 60 min) in just one week, finishing with two public performances. It is fast, it is full-on, and it is one of the most rewarding weeks of the year!

In one week your child will:

- Learn a complete scripted junior musical from scratch
- Be taught all the songs, choreography and blocking by an experienced production team.
- Rehearse in a friendly, encouraging team environment
- Perform the show two times (ticketed performances)
- Receive an official cast T-shirt & Script
- Make new friends and come home buzzing with confidence

Legally Blonde JR. follows the transformation of Elle Woods as she tackles stereotypes, snobbery and scandal in pursuit of her dreams. When Elle's high school boyfriend, Warner, dumps her and heads to Harvard, claiming she's not "serious" enough, Elle takes matters into her own hands, crafting a showy song-and-dance personal essay and charming her way into law school. Befriending classmate, Emmett, and spunky hairdresser, Paulette, along the way, Elle finds that books and looks aren't mutually exclusive. As Elle begins outsmarting her peers, she realizes that law may be her natural calling after all.

- Use a **backing track** (no a cappella performances).
- Ensure you have completed the **Audition Registration Form** and included the link to your audition video

KATE

Kate is a featured Delta Nu sister - the academic of the bunch.

WARNER HUNTINGTON III

Warner Huntington III is He is Elle's ex-boyfriend and caught between his former life with Elle and his newfound serious east coast life with Vivienne.

ADMISSION OFFICERS

Winthrop, Lowell and Pforzheimer are three admissions officers of Harvard Law School who eventually admit Elle into the program after some critical evaluation.
